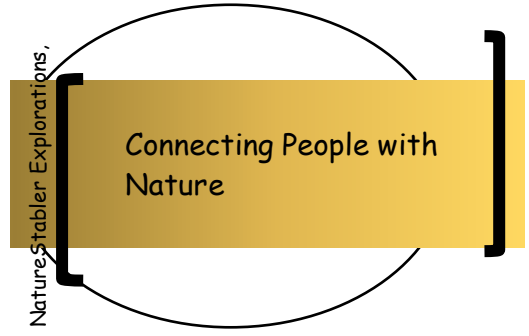
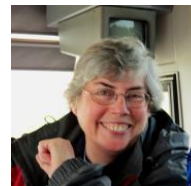

What to expect: Weather and Sightings

The birds migrate through this area because of the weather and geography. Depending on what fronts are moving into the area, the birds “pile-up” waiting to cross the mouth of the Chesapeake Bay with favorable fronts. This can also be the southern destination for many who are used to cold, just not frozen tundra. It is a great water fowl wintering grounds.

Bring along a pair of binoculars, wind/rain gear and water resistant shoes/boots. This is a great opportunity for experienced and novice birders, as well as avid beach folks to experience the birds and beach!
