BIRD SEED ORDER FORM

SEED DESCRIPTION

BLACK OIL SUNFLOWER: The most popular seed with most seed eating birds. Is a high energy feed source for the cold winter months.

PREMIUM MIX: A premium mix consisting of the most attractive seed for most wild birds including 28% Black Oil Sunflower, Safflower, White Millet, Peanut Chips, and Wheat.

ECONOMY MIX: A popular mix of 5% Black Oil Sunflower, White Millet, Wheat, and Cracked Corn.

CRACKED CORN: Medium cracked, an economical feed preferred by Sparrows, Doves, and Juncos. Can also be used for feeding pheasants and squirrels.

SAFFLOWER SEED: A popular seed for Cardinals, which squirrels do not prefer.

NYJER SEED: Very small, dark colored seeds especially well liked by Goldfinches.

SUNFLOWER HEARTS: Same as Black Oil Sunflower, but without the messy shells.

PEANUTS IN THE SHELL: Can be used in hanging peanut feeder to attract Woodpeckers, Nuthatches and Wrens. Place on platform feeder to attract Blue Jays, Cardinals, Tufted Titmouse and Squirrels.
